1. VSE (under 91cm)

- **2.** Pony (91cm under 124cm)
- **3.** Pony (124cm ne 149cm)
- **4.** Horse (over 149cm)
- **5.** Multiples

RIBBONS AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded to third place in each class. Prizes to third place will be awarded in each class for the whole competition based on the best TWO scores for the same combination.

DRESSAGE

The test will be ACDS Novice No 2.

Drivers should be well presented with aprons optional. 10 penalties if a caller is used.

CONES:

Will be run as a fault competition. You MUST include the wheel width you will be using in competition A and C on the entry form.

OBSTATHON

The Obstathon will consist of two marathon Obstacles gated to D and approximately 10 cone obstacles. It is a timed event. Each combination will drive the course twice. 5 seconds added for each ball down. Complying helmets mandatory for driver and groom.

ENTRY FEE:

\$30 for each combination.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Drivers must be <u>full</u> ACDS members. Club Receipts or current Membership Cards must be produced if requested.
- 2. All competitors compete at their own risk. The Toowoomba Regional Council, Goombungee and Haden Show Society, Range Carriage Club Inc., the event organising committee and all landholders involved, accept no responsibility for loss or damage to horses, owners, drivers, grooms, spectators, equipment, or any other person or property whatsoever, whilst at or near the venue, during this event.
- 3. Equines 124cm and over must have a groom.
- 4. A competitor driving a single Horse or Pony must have attained their 12th birthday, for Pony multiples, their 16th birthday and for Horse multiples, their 18th birthday. An experienced adult ACDS member must accompany all competitors under the age of 16 years driving a single Horse or Pony and all competitors 16 or 17 years of age driving a Pony multiple. Grooms must have attained their 10th birthday for singles and 14th birthday for multiples to participate at ACDS events. Whenever a junior is in a vehicle, they must be wearing a complying helmet as per the 'Rules for Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events', whether they are members or non-members.
 - * A Junior is a person who is under 18 years of age as at the date of the event.
- 5. Whenever a horse is harnessed to a vehicle, an ACDS member must be in the vehicle holding the reins with suitable contact.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to:
 - Alter any advertised times; Refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason; Measure any horse or pony upon discretion; reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class.
- 7. Dogs must be on a leash at all times, and owners must clean up after their dogs.
- 8. No vehicle with a wheel width less than 125cm will be accepted.
